Péter Zámbo: Prologue. The role of the Hungarian Border Guard in keeping Public Order and in the Process leading to Integration.

The long traditions of Hungarian border patrol, the culture of controlling and defending borders fortify us and give guidance for the adaption of changes and for successful and effective technical activities securing common (social) goals and interests. Due to the affiliation to Schengen the Border Guard of the Hungarian Republic is being dissolved on 1 January, 2008 and its role is being inherited by the police. In the recent past this integration is the biggest enterprise of order protection, consequently its results and the quality of the integration of the tasks and the border guard units into the police cannot be negligible.

Géza Finszter: The Functions of Law Enforcement and the Integration of Hungarian Border Guard

The most important characteristic of the preparations for the integration of Border Guard was that they were carried out as the part of a state reform and not as the part of a broad law enforcement strategy. The other characteristic was that the original conception wanted to combine the integration with the conversion to regional system, but it was not supported politically. The preparatory consultations ensured possibility for detailed and manifold introduction of the parties' conceptions relating to the integration. Due to the different interpretations of integration and the competing professional interests, very different conceptions came out. They often differed from the theoretical principles of the confirmed Conception.

Attila Piros: Fragments of the process of law enforcement integration

In order to guarantee a secure Europe, the effective operation of different kinds of law enforcement organizations became necessary. The member states worked out different solutions with regard to historical traditions and the requirements of citizens to comply these tasks. Some efforts of the recent past have to be emphasised, for example the German law enforcement integration at the time of the two states' union, the Belgian and the Austrian order protection reforms.
